- Minimum of 2 years of relevant working experience in a busy renal unit setup
- Proficient in computers and Health information systems
- Confident, organized, and with excellent communication and patient handling skills
- Critical thinking, analytical and problem-solving skills
- Ethical, empathetic and customer-focused.
- Able to work with minimal supervision

Roles and Responsibilities.

- Ensuring that dialysis treatments are administered to patients correctly as per standard protocol
- Checking and recording patients' vitals before, during, and after dialysis treatment.
- Monitoring patients during dialysis treatment to identify any adverse reactions.

- Promptly notify the appropriate medical practitioner of any problems that occur during dialysis treatments.
- Working with the Biomedical team to ensure that dialysis machines and equipment are set up correctly
- Educating patients on dialysis treatment options, kidney disease management, as well as suitable nutrition and exercise regimens.
- Ensure accurate documentation, proper record keeping {and storage for continuity, quality, and legal reference.
- Assist medical staff in the overall care of the patient and to ensure the prescribed treatment is given.
- Perform any other duties as may be assigned by the supervisor /superintending nephrologist from time to time.
